NOTIFICATION

F. No. 50(5)/DC/Estt./2023/.....In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the constitution read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. F.24/78/68-DH(S) dated 24.09.1968 and in supersession of the Notification No. F.53/144/94-H&FW/4052 dated 29.01.2001, the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi hereby makes rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Junior Scientific Officer (Pharmacology) in the Drugs Control Department, Govt. of N.C.T. of Delhi as following, namely:

1. **Short title and commencement-**
 - (i) These rules may be called the Drugs Control Department, Junior Scientific Officer (Pharmacology) Recruitment Rules, 2023
 - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Number of post, Classification and Scale of pay-** The number of the said post, its classification and the pay level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule aforesaid.
4. **Disqualification.-** No person,
 - (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
5. **Power to Relax-** Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. **Saving-** Nothing in these rules, shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

(A) (i) Post Graduate Degree in Pharmacology/ Pharmacy/ Biochemistry/ Zoology from a Recognised University

(ii) Three Years' Experience in the field of Pharmacological testing of drugs from an Institution recognized by a Government Body

OR

(B) (i) A Graduate Degree in Pharmacy/ Science (with Chemistry, Botany and Zoology) from a Recognised University or equivalent

(ii) Five years' Experience in the field of Pharmacological testing of Drugs from an Institution recognized by a Government Body

Note 1: The Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for appointment by deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: Period of deputation/ contract including the period of deputation/ contract in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/ department of the central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years

Note 3: The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including Short-term contract) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications
